# About the Teacher Website

The Teacher website for Penjii Protects the Planet allows you to register your students so they can log in to the game, make specific levels available to them and also provides a number of teaching resources which you can use in the classroom to support sustainability education. The teacher section also show which of your students has scored the highest in the game if you want to reward effort/ learning.

The process for using the game and the teacher website involves:

- 1) Register and log into the Teacher Website
- 2) Create User Accounts for your students
- 3) Release a specific level for students to play
- 4) Following the in-game learning with in-class activities

# 1) Register and log into the Teacher Website

To use the teacher website, first go to <u>https://teachers.penjiithegame.com</u> From here, you register for an account by pressing the green "Sign Up" button on the right-hand side





Bulk create accounts for multiple students

You can also also bulk-upload a lot of student accounts by creating their account in a spreadsheet (e.g. by using software such as Microsoft Excel). To do this, access "Bulk Users Management" in the menu on the left-hand side



To download the file which you can use to create a large number of users, click on the "Download Template" button on the left-hand side.



This will download a .CSV file called "penji-bulkupload.csv" which you can upload in software such as Microsoft Excel. From here, you can simply add a list of names, usernames and passwords.

- It is also recommended that you make the password for all students something simple and that you give all students the same password.

Level 1 - Climate Change and its impact


Level 2 - Biodiversity and plastic pollution

You can release a specific level to students by accessing "Level Management" in the menu on the left-hand side



You can see which levels are locked or not locked for your students in the "User Table" on the right-hand side. You can lock or unlock levels for a specific student by pressing on the Unlocked/ Locked button for that student for the level.

# Have students play the game

Students can log in to the game using the username and password you have created for them. You can have students play the game in-class, or outside of class.

In the game, students will be asked to answer questions on climate change and be given tips on how we can all reduce our impact on climate change. If they answer questions correctly, they will be able to keep playing - so the more they know, the more points they will accumulate.



The game will track which student scores the highest in the game. This is shown in the dashboard of <u>https://teachers.penjiithegame.com/</u> and is available in the game under "Leaderboard" when students are logged in.

This can be used to reward students who do well in the game.





## Some other in-class Activities

Some other in-class activities which can be done in-class include

#### 1) Host a debate

Host a debate in class with the motion "A plant based diet is better for the environment" or something along those lines.

You could also focus on trying some vegetarian recipes and meat alternatives in class. Show or discuss with students what are the nutritional qualities of the foods? Do they taste nice? What other motivations do people have for eating a meat-free diet (religious/animal welfare/cost, etc.)?
